The Museum is situated between Mill and Marsh Meadows on the banks of the River Thames. Our grounds include:

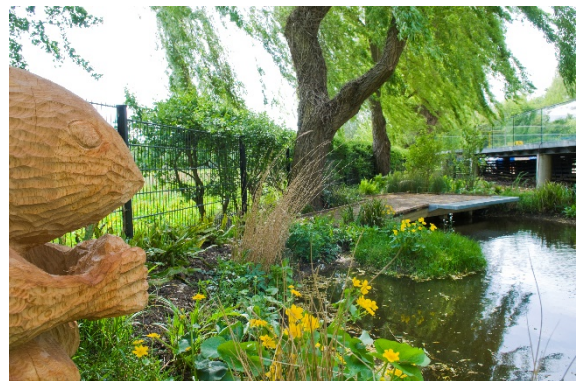
- A Wildlife Walkway
